***Deadline: November 30, 2016***

Applicants must plan to graduate from a US high school in spring 2017, intend to enroll in an accredited four-year college beginning in fall 2017, earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above, SAT combined critical reading and math score of 1200 (based on the old SAT scores) or above and/or ACT composite score of 26 or above, and demonstrate significant unmet financial need. ***Deadline: January 4, 2017***

The contest is open to United States high school students in grades nine through twelve attending public, private, parochial, or home schools. Must complete an essay that can be no more than 1,000 words but must be a minimum of 700 words. First-place winner receives \$20,000. Second-place winner receives \$1,000. ## The Tom Joyner Foundation - 'Full Ride' Scholarship

***Deadline: January 20, 2017***

This scholarship will cover all the expenses of one student planning to attend a Historically Black College and University (HBCU) in the fall of 2017. Must be a US Citizen, current high school senior attending school in the United States (applicant must be anticipating completion of high school degree in the spring of 2017). Minimum high school GPA of 3.50, minimum SAT score of 1600 (combined math essay and verbal score) or ACT score of 30. **Applicants must apply and be accepted to an HBCU by July 1, 2017.** Applicants must have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities.
