application process

What is the Governor's Honors Program?

- GHP is a four week program for gifted and talented students. Finalists take courses in their major (nomination) area as well as an elective (formerly minor) course. The program has been in existence since 1963, and it is the longest running program of its kind in the United States.
- Students can participate in the program through a variety of nomination areas.

Who can participate?

- The Governor's Honors Program is a summer program for rising juniors and seniors. Students can apply in the 10th or 11th grade.
- Students are only allowed to participate in GHP one time, however, students who were nominated in their sophomore year and were not selected can reapply for the program in their junior year.
